You may also want to bring bug spray and anything else you think you'd like to have in order to spend a few hours in the woods comfortably. If you'd like to bring loppers or a hand saw that would be fine. We will also have tools to share. Please do not bring any powered tools like chain saws or striking tools like axes or machetes.
